

## A FISTFUL OF POWER: AGUASCALIENTES CONFERENCE MEXICO, 1914

The Mexican Revolution is over, again. The first wave of revolutions came when Francisco Madero overthrew the dictatorship of Porfirio Diaz, but Madero was soon executed and replaced in a military coup by Victoriano Huerta. Now Huerta's regime has been toppled, but before victory can be declared, the many leaders of the revolution must settle their differences.

Venustiano Carranza is the nominal head of the entire revolution, but is now seen as elitist and detached from the people. Pancho Villa is the opposite, a former bandit who rose to become the revolution's most famous general, even earning a spot in Hollywood films. Alvaro Obregon, the country's shrewdest military mind, comes to the table with his own agenda. Meanwhile, Emiliano Zapata, who has long led guerilla fighters in Morelos in the struggle for indigenous land rights, takes his place in the negotiations as well. Alongside these four men, their generals, allies, and even representatives of the Mexican people will meet at the Convention of Aguascalientes to settle the country's future.

Will a concord for peace emerge for the convention, or two, or three, or four factions form for civil war? Only the actions of the delegates to the convention can determine the terms of peace or war. Whatever the country ends up, the powers that be will put a hand on the scale, whether it be the influential Catholic Church or a newly emboldened United States under Woodrow Wilson.

So it remains to be seen: when you put Mexico's four biggest egos in one room, what's the worst that could happen?
