ALL THE NEWS THAT'S FIT TO PRINT: THE INAUGURAL SUMMIT ON JOURNALISTS' RIGHTS, 2019

Shortly after walking into the Saudi consulate in Istanbul to obtain legal documents, Washington Post journalist Jamal Khashoggi was kidnapped and brutally murdered. His assassination, although originally denied by the Saudi government, was a direct response to the anti-nationalist pieces he had written over the course of his career. The Inaugural Journalists' Rights Summit begins only four months after this attack, with the aim to explore internationally-prescient questions such as: was this act justified, how "free" is free speech in practice, and what, if any, protections should be put in place for journalists moving forward?

This will be a double-delegation committee. There are no position papers due.

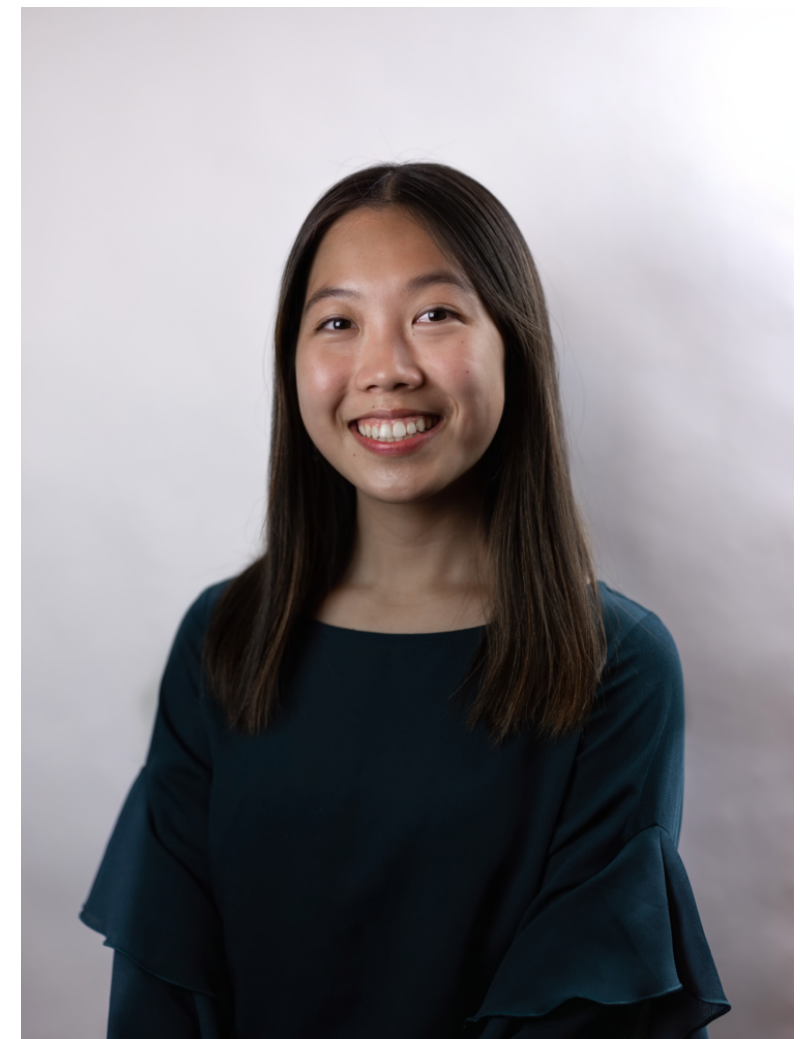
